Dear Demo Derby Participant:

It is again time to start thinking about the annual BONNERS FERRY LIONS CLUB DEMO DERBY!
Through your support and participation this has become a great event!

This year's event will be very similar to last years with the exception of some rules standardization.
Review your rules sheet for important changes about drivers door painting and marking. Also check the
line about fuel tanks. This will be enforced this year.

The winner will receive \$1,200 plus a trophy. The 2nd place winner will receive \$750.00 plus a trophy.
The 3rd place winner will receive \$300.00 plus a trophy. New this year is a "Last Chance Qualifier" heat
before the Main instead of the "Hard Luck." There will be no trophy or heat pay out, just another chance
to get into the "Main Event." Heat payouts will depend upon the number of registrations. Roughly one
third of the heat participants will win back their entry fees. Not bad! There will be a "Compact Car Heat"
again this year as long as we have at least 6 or more cars with a 50% return of this heats entry fee. Same
Prep rules and safety rules apply here. The entry fees will remain the same at \$50.00. We are not limiting
the cars, all that come are welcome!

All Derby cars must be removed by 11:00 A.M. Sunday morning to allow for timely cleanup of the area.
Drivers will be charged for towing if their cars are not removed.

1. Drivers and pit crew must obey all rules or they will be disqualified. Maximum of 2 pit crew members.
2. Drivers must be 18 years old or older; no one under 18 allowed, no exceptions. **ALL DRIVERS ENTER AT THEIR OWN RISK.**
3. Safety Equipment: Seat belts and shoulder harness are required, will be tested, and must be worn; an approved crash helmet will be worn; a 2 ½ lb. dry chemical fire extinguisher in each car at the right of the driver is mandatory; a roll bar is optional, but it may not structurally reinforce the car.
4. Any driver and/or pit crew caught consuming alcoholic beverages or using drugs will be disqualified.
5. American passenger cars and standard wagons only. No pickups, jeeps or ambulances. Cutting of body parts will be allowed. Radiator must remain in original position or be removed. All equipment must be standard, no studded snow tires, and no body alterations.
6. No reinforcement of frame or body parts, except for the driver's door. If the driver's door is reinforced, the material cannot extend more than 6 inches beyond the outer limits of the driver's door. Driver's door opening thickness of reinforcement not to exceed 3 inches including hardware. Passenger front door may also be reinforced, same rules apply (like Driver's door).
7. The driver's door must be painted white and will bear no other markings. The car's number will be assigned upon acceptance of the application. Preferences will be considered on a first request basis. Numbers will be as large as possible on roof and passenger side and be legible.
8. All glass, mirrors, lenses, chrome, body moldings, pot metal, metal trim, headliners, carpet, inside door panels, and anything breakable or loose, must be removed prior to arrival at the event location.
9. Original fuel tank must be removed. A supplemental tank (maximum capacity 3-6 gallon) shall be placed in the rear passenger area, rigidly secured and covered with metal or rubber. This tank may not contain more than 5 gallons of fuel. Fuel injected cars may use original tank, but must be mounted in rear seat area.
10. No reserve water tanks.
11. A screen must be placed over the driver's windshield.
12. Battery must be covered with rubber to prevent acid spill in case of roll-over, also the battery can be moved to the cab if secured on the floor or on the passenger seat and covered with rubber. Two batteries are allowed.
13. Engine must be in the original location and have factory motor mounts; engines may be chained down.
14. Car's engine hood must be chained or bolted but not both and must be able to be opened for inspection. One eighteen-inch fire hole is required in the engine hood.

15. Trunks may be chained with 4 chains not totaling more than 8', **OR** welded shut with no more than 12" total weld, **OR** bolted with a total of 4 bolts-- but only **ONE** method used. If trunk is permanently shut, an inspection hole of 12 to 15 inches is required. No chains around bumpers or frame or trunk floor.
15. a. Door welds are unlimited.
16. Ether starting fluid may not be used in the arena. If found in the car during or after the race, the car, driver, and pit crew are disqualified.
17. First, second, and third place cars will be inspected in the arena immediately following the championship event. All cars must remain in the arena during inspection.
18. No altering or increasing the weight of the car. No sand or concrete can be used in any part of the auto, including the tires. Trailer hitches must be completely removed so no reinforcement remains. Towing from the arena will be done only by specific authorization from the derby sponsor.
19. Anything in question will be decided on by the **derby inspectors**.
20. Immediate disqualification will result if you: (1) hit a driver's door (Exception - if pushed into the driver's door by another car), (2) remove your seat belt or helmet, or leave your car for any reason during the heat (Exception - if your car is on fire).
21. Any abusive language or action directed toward derby officials will result in disqualification of vehicle, driver, and pit crew.
22. If your car is disqualified by these rules, the entry fee will not be refunded.
23. No one under the age of 16 will be allowed in the pit area.
24. No white cars.
25. If black flagged, the driver is out for the remainder of the heat. The heat will be stopped by means of an air horn. The driver will break his stick and the heat will be restarted.
26. No lights or sirens.
27. Sticks will be provided for cars. Sticks are to be broke off when you are timed out or black flagged.
28. Compact car limit: Wheel base a maximum of 107 inches.

REFEREE'S AND DRIVER'S REGULATIONS

1. All cars will be inspected prior to the derby. If corrections are needed they must be completed before the first heat starts or cars will be disqualified from the competition.
2. The competition will start with the cars all backing in a center point and the referee will start by waving green flag.
3. An assistant referee will be stationed on each of the four corners of the arena with fire extinguishers and flags.
